



## **Special Press Release**

### **Subject: Weather Over Uttarakhand From 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2016.**

Western Disturbances and an east-west trough from Punjab to Northwest Bay of Bengal in lower levels with embedded cyclonic circulations one over Punjab and neighbourhood and another over southeast Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood are likely to affect northwest India including **Uttarakhand** mainly from 3<sup>rd</sup> May to 6<sup>th</sup> May 2016.

### **Expected Weather:**

- a.** Maximum temperatures are likely to fall markedly from 4<sup>th</sup> May onwards and will remain near or below normal during next 5-6 days.
- b.** Under the influence of above weather systems, fairly widespread light to moderate thunderstorm activities are expected and leading to:
  - (i) Light to moderate rainfall at many places on 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> May, and,
  - (ii) Very light to light rainfall at a few places with moderate rainfall at isolated places on 6<sup>th</sup> May in Uttarakhand.

### **Warnings:**

- (i) Thunder squall speed reaching 60-70 KMPH likely at isolated places in Uttarakhand on 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> May.
- (ii) Hailstorm also likely at isolated places on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> May.

### **Advisory:**

- (i) Farmers are advised to take necessary precautionary measures to prevent damage to crops wherever possible.
- (ii) The water management authorities are advised to take necessary measures to use rainwater.
- (iii) In view of strong winds (squall)/hail damage to kutcha houses and twigs & branches of trees likely at isolated places. People are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.
