Sub: Wet spell over Uttarakhand from 05th to 11th June, 2018

Current meteorological analysis and model predictions suggest strong moisture flow over Uttarakhand due to existence of trough in lower levels from Punjab to Bay of Bengal. The existence of lower level convergence, unstable atmospheric conditions and orography are likely to trigger fairly widespread to widespread rain/ thunderstorm activities over Uttarakhand from 05th to 11th June, 2018.

Rainfall:

Under the influence of above conditions:

- Light to moderate rain/thunderstorms very likely to occur at many places on 05th, 7th & 11th June 2018 in Uttarakhand.
- Light to moderate rain/thunderstorms very likely to occur at most places on 06th, 8th, 9th & 10th June 2018 in Uttarakhand.

Warning(Alert):

- **Thunder Squall speed reaching 70-80 Kmph likely to occur at isolated places especially in Dehradun, Haridwar, Pauri, Nainital and U.S. Nagar districts of Uttarakhand on 05th & 6th June 2018.**
- **Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places especially in Uttarkashi, Chamoli Rudraprayag, Dehradun, Pauri and Nainital districts of Uttarakhand on 10th June 2018.**

Remark:

- During the above weather activities, isolated intense heavy rain showers of the order of 40 mm to 60 mm in a short duration say within an hour, likely to occur and cause landslides and flash flood in small channels and revolute at isolated places in hills of Uttarakhand.
