Sub: Weather Over Uttarakhand During Next Week (7th to 13th May, 2016).

An east-west trough from Punjab to Northwest Bay of Bengal in lower levels with embedded cyclonic circulations one over Punjab and neighbourhood and another over east Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood is likely to prevail during 9th to 13th May, 2016. A Western Disturbance (WD) also likely to move across Afghanistan, North Pakistan and Northern parts of Jammu & Kashmir during 11th to 13th May.

Expected Weather:

(A) Rainfall:

Under the influence of above systems, scattered to fairly widespread light to moderate thunderstorm activities are expected and leading to:

- (i) Light to moderate rainfall at many places on 12th and 13th May and,
- (ii) Very light to light rainfall at many places on 11th May and at a few places on 9th & 10th May with moderate rainfall at isolated places in Uttarakhand.

(B) Temperatures:

The maximum temperatures are likely to remain near normal or below normal over the State on most of the days during the week.

Advisory:

- (i) Farmers are advised to take necessary measures as per need.
- (ii) The water management authorities are advised to take necessary measures to use rainwater.
