✚ Sub: Weather over Uttarakhand from 14th to 20th July, 2016

The western end of monsoon trough (MT) likely to shift northwards from 14th July and remain close to foothills of Himalaya during 15th to 20th July with cyclonic circulation over west Uttar Pradesh and adjoining Uttarakhand in lower levels from 15th to 17th July and the eastern end of MT would continue to remain into north Bay of Bengal till 17th and shift northwards thereafter towards northeastern states. A western Disturbance as an upper air trough also likely to meander over Afghanistan and North Pakistan from 14th to 20th July.

✚ Rainfall:

Under the influence of above systems:

- **Moderate rain/thundershowers very likely to occur at most places on 15th and 16th July over Uttarakhand**
- Light to moderate rain/thundershowers most likely to occur at many places on 14th and 17th July and at a few places on 18th, 19th and 20th over Uttarakhand.

✚ Warning:

Heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely to occur at one or two places especially in Uttarkashi, Dehradun, Rudraprayag, Chamoli, Pithoragarh, Bageshwar, Almora, Nainital and Champawat districts of Uttarakhand during next 72 hours starting from evening of 14th July.

✚ Advisory:

In view of isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over Uttarakhand during mentioned period, people/yatris are advised to remain vigilant and take necessary precautionary measures.
