Sub: Weather over Uttarakhand from 20th to 26th May, 2016

A trough in lower levels runs from North Rajasthan to the centre of the Cyclonic Storm “ROANU” over Northwest Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood with embedded cyclonic circulation over North Rajasthan & neighbourhood. The trough is likely to shift northwards and run from North Punjab to northwest Bay of Bengal across north Haryana and Northwest Uttar Pradesh on 23rd and 24th May. A Western Disturbance is also likely to move across North Pakistan and Jammu & Kashmir during 23rd to 24th May.

Rainfall:

Under the influence of above systems:

- Light to moderate rain/thunderstorm activities are likely to occur at isolated to few places from 20th to 22nd May over Uttarakhand.
- **Light to moderate rain/thunderstorm activities are likely to occur at many places on 23rd and 24th May, 2016 and decrease thereafter.**

Temperature:

Maximum temperatures are likely to remain 1 to 2 degree Celsius above normal on most of the days of the week and thus no chances of development of heat wave conditions over Uttarakhand during the period.

Warning:

Hail/Thunder squall (speed reaching 60-70 KMPH) likely at isolated places in Uttarakhand on 20th & 21st and again on 23rd & 24th May, 2016.
