Sub: Wet spell over Uttarakhand on 26th and 27th January, 2017

A western disturbance as an upper air system and its induced cyclonic circulation at lower levels is likely to affect Uttarakhand on 26th and 27th January 2017.

Rainfall:

Under the influence of above systems:

- Light to moderate rain/snowfall likely to occur at most places on 26th and at many places on 27th January. (Snowfall likely to occur at places with height 2000m and above)
- The main rain/snowfall activity over Garhwal region likely from evening/night of 26th to forenoon/noon of 27th and over Kumaun region from night/late night of 26th to evening/night of 27th January.

Warning(Alert):

- Heavy rain/snowfall likely to occur at isolated places in Uttarakhand especially in Uttarkashi, Chamoli, Rudraprayag, Pithoragarh, Tehri, Dehradun and Hardwar districts during next 24 hours starting from evening/night of 26th January 2017 (Heavy snowfall likely to occur at places with height 3000m and above).
- Hailstorm likely to occur at isolated places in plains of Uttarakhand especially in Hardwar, Pauri and Udham Singh Nagar districts during next 24 hours starting from evening/night of 26th January 2017.

Temperatures and Fog:

Due to the passage of western disturbance and subsequent prevalence of Northwesterly wind flow over the state; the minimum temperatures are very likely to fall below normal by 2 to 4 degree Celsius in many parts of the state and the fog is also likely over some parts of plains of Uttarakhand especially in U S Nagar and Hardwar districts during next 2 to 3 days from 28th January onwards.
