**WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NW INDIA
INCLUDING DELHI NCR FOR NEXT SEVEN DAYS**

Subject: Adverse weather over North-west India from 29th April to 30th April, 2017

A fresh Western Disturbance as an upper air cyclonic circulation lies over Afghanistan. An induced circulation is likely to form over Punjab and Haryana with moisture incursion taking place in the region. Under the influence of these systems weather is expected over north-west India on 29th April and 30th April, 2017 and same is as follows:-

- Scattered to Fairly Widespread rainfall likely to occur over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand and isolated to scattered over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan on 29th April and 30th April, 2017.

Warning

- Thunderstorm accompanied with squall / hail very likely to occur at isolated places over Jammu and Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 29th & 30th April, 2017.
- Thunderstorm accompanied with squall very likely to occur at isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi, West-Uttar Pradesh on 29th & 30th April, 2017.
- Thunderstorm accompanied with squall very likely at isolated places over East-Rajasthan on 29th April, 2017.

Weather over National Capital Region (NCR)

- One or two spells of Thunderstorm / Dust storm accompanied with squally winds reaching 55 kmph or more likely to occur on 29th and 30th April, 2017 at a few places over Delhi and NCR.
