**WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NW INDIA
INCLUDING DELHI NCR**

Subject: Adverse weather over north-west India from 28th May to 31st May, 2017

A fresh Western Disturbance is likely to affect north-west India from night of 27th May 2017. A trough is likely to form in lower levels from Punjab to North Bay of Bengal across Haryana, Delhi and West Uttar Pradesh with an embedded upper air circulation over Punjab and adjoining area and another over Uttar Pradesh. The trough is likely to persist during the period from 28th May to 31st May 2017. Under the influence of these systems weather is expected over north-west India during this period and the details are as follows:-

- Fairly Widespread to Widespread rainfall activity likely to occur over Uttarakhand and Scattered to Fairly Widespread rainfall activity likely to occur over Himachal Pradesh during the period from 28th May to 31st May, 2017.
- Scattered to Fairly Widespread rainfall activity likely to occur over Uttar Pradesh during the period 28th May to 30th May, 2017. Scattered rainfall activity likely to continue over East-Uttar Pradesh on 31st May, 2017.
- Scattered to Fairly Widespread rainfall activities likely to occur over Punjab, Haryana and Chandigarh on 29th May, 2017.

Warning

- Thunderstorm accompanied with squall / hail very likely to occur at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 28st to 30th May, 2017 and over Himachal Pradesh on 29th to 30th May, 2017. Isolated heavy rainfall likely to occur over Uttarakhand on 29th May, 2017
- Thunderstorm accompanied with squall very likely to occur at isolated places over Punjab, Haryana and Chandigarh on 29th May, 2017.

Weather over National Capital Region (NCR)

- One or two spells of Rain / Thunderstorm accompanied with squally winds reaching 55 kmph or more likely to occur at a few places over Delhi and NCR during the period from night of 27th to 29nd May, 2017. Peak activity is likely to occur on 29st May, 2017.
