**WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NW INDIA
INCLUDING DELHI NCR FOR NEXT SEVEN DAYS**

Conditions are favourable for further advance of southwest-monsoon into remaining parts of East-Uttar Pradesh during next 48 hours. Rapid advancement of southwest monsoon is very likely into most parts of Northwest-India including entire Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Haryana, Chandigarh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir during next 4-5 days. This is due to Northwest-movement of low pressure, which is currently located over Northwest-Bay of Bengal and neighbourhood and its likely interaction with approaching western disturbance.

Under the influence of above system weather is expected over Northwest-India as follows-

- *Widespread rainfall activity likely to occur over Jammu & Kashmir on 28th and 29th June
- * Scattered to fairly wide spread rainfall activity likely to occur over Himachal Pradesh and East-Rajasthan on 26th June
- * Fairly wide spread to widespread rainfall activity likely to occur over Uttarakhand from 26th to 29th June
- *Widespread rainfall activity likely to occur over Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh from 27th to 29th June and Fairly wide spread to wide spread rainfall activity over Rajasthan from 26th to 29th June.

Warning.

Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir on 29th June.

Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, West-Uttar Pradesh and South East-Rajasthan from 27th to 29th June.

Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places over Punjab and East-Uttar Pradesh on 28th and 29th June.

Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places over Uttarakhand on 27th and 29th June, with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 28th June 2017.

Weather over National Capital Region (NCR)

Rain / Thunderstorm activity is likely to commence from 26th June evening over Delhi NCR. Light to moderate rain / thunderstorm activity is likely to occur at many places between 27th , 30 June over Delhi NCR with peak activity on 29 June .
