**WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NW INDIA
INCLUDING DELHI NCR FOR NEXT SEVEN DAYS**

The axis of monsoon trough at mean sea level is close to foothills of Himalayas. As a result weather activity is presently confined to the foothills. An upper air cyclonic circulation is presently marked over south Bangladesh & adjoining northeast Bay of Bengal extending upto 7.6 km above mean sea level sloping southwestwards with height. Under its influence a low pressure area is likely to develop over the same area during next 24 hours. This low pressure is likely to move West North-westwards.

As result the axis of monsoon trough is likely to shift southwards from foothills and fresh surge in monsoon activity is likely to ensue over plains of Northwest India during next 48 hours. Under the influence of above systems weather expected over Northwest-India is as follows:-

- Widespread rainfall activity is likely to occur over Uttarakhand from 5th to 8th;
- Fairly widespread to widespread over Himachal Pradesh from 5th to 9th;
- Scattered over Punjab from 6th to 8th ;
- Scattered to fairly widespread over Haryana from 6th to 8th ;
- Scattered to fairly widespread over west Uttar Pradesh from 5th to 7th & widespread on 8th ;
- Fairly widespread to widespread over east Uttar Pradesh from 5th to 8th and scattered to fairly widespread over east Rajasthan on 7th & 8th August.

Weather Warning:-

- Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places over Uttarakhand during 6th to 8th;
- Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh during 7th & 8th;
- Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh from 6th to 8th and over East Rajasthan on 8th Aug.

Weather over Delhi/National Capital Region (NCR) :-

- Two to three spells of Rain/ Thundershowers are likely to occur over Delhi/NCR during the period commencing from 5th evening to 9th afternoon.
