WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NW INDIA INCLUDING DELHI NCR

- The axis of monsoon trough at mean sea level now passes through Bikaner, Ajmer, centre of the well marked low pressure area over Northern parts of central Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood, Pendra Road, Jharsiguda, Paradip and thence east-southeastwards to east central Bay of Bengal.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over Northwest-Rajasthan & neighbourhood and extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- The Western Disturbance as an upper air cyclonic circulation over central Pakistan & adjoining Punjab now lies over Eastern parts of Jammu & Kashmir and adjoining Himachal Pradesh at 3.1 km above mean sea level.
- The other Western Disturbance as an upper air cyclonic circulation over eastern parts of Afghanistan & neighbourhood between 3.1 & 5.8 km above mean sea level persists with the trough aloft with its axis at 7.6 km above mean sea level now running roughly along Longitude 65.0°E to the north of Latitude 27.0°N.

Weather is expected over north west India:-

- Fairly wide spread to wide spread rain/thundershowers is likely to occur over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and East Rajasthan on 22nd and 23rd September and over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and East Uttar Pradesh on 24th September.
- Isolated to scattered Rain/Thundershowers is likely to occur over Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab and West Rajasthan from 22nd to 24th September.

WEATHER WARNING

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places over Uttarakhand and West Uttar Pradesh on 22nd and 23rd September.
- Heavy Rain/Thundershowers likely to occur over Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi on 22nd and 23rd September and over East Uttar Pradesh and East Rajasthan on 21st and 22nd September.

Weather over Delhi & NCR

- One or two spells of Rain/Thundershowers is likely to occur at many places over Delhi and NCR on 22nd and 23rd September.
