**WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NW INDIA INCLUDING DELHI NCR**

The axis of monsoon trough at mean sea level passes through Jalore, Ratlam, centre of well marked low pressure area over southwest Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood, Seoni, Rajnandgaon, Koraput, Visakhapatnam and thence to westcentral Bay of Bengal. The Western disturbance as an upper air cyclonic circulation lies over north Pakistan & neighbourhood between 3.1 Km & 4.5 Km at mean sea level. As a result monsoon trough is likely to shift northwards from 31<sup>st</sup> Aug resulting increase in weather activity over the planes of NW-India from 31<sup>st</sup> August.

**Weather is expected over Northwest-India**

- Fairly wide spread to widespread rain/thundershower is likely to occur over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi & Uttar Pradesh on 31<sup>st</sup> Aug and 1<sup>st</sup> Sep.
- Isolated to Scattered rain/thundershower is likely to occur over Jammu and Kashmir and Rajasthan on 31<sup>st</sup> Aug. and 1<sup>st</sup> Sep.

**Weather Warning**

- Heavy to Very Heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Uttarakhand and Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi & Uttar Pradesh 31<sup>st</sup> Aug and 1<sup>st</sup> Sep.

**Weather over National Capital Region (NCR)**

**A spell of Rain / Thundershower is likely to occur at many places over Delhi NCR on 31<sup>st</sup> August / 1<sup>st</sup> September.**
