WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NW INDIA INCUDING DELHI NCR FOR NEXT SEVEN DAYS

A Western Disturbance is likely to affect North West India from 12th November night to 16th November. In association with this system an induced cyclonic circulation is likely to form over West Rajasthan and adjoining Pakistan, with moisture incursion taking place in the region. Under the influence of these systems weather is expected over North West India during 13th November to 16th November. Detail of expected weather are as follows:-

Weather expected over North West India:-

- Scattered to fairly wide spread rainfall / snowfall activity is likely to occur over Jammu & Kashmir on 14th and 15th and Isolated rainfall / snowfall activity on 16th November.
- Isolated to scattered rainfall / snowfall activity is likely to occur over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 14th and 15th November.
- Scattered to fairly wide spread Rain / Thundershowers activity is likely to occur over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Isolated to scattered rainfall activity over North Rajasthan on 14th and 15th November.
- Isolated rainfall/ thundershowers activity over North West Uttar Pradesh on 15th November.

Weather over Delhi & NCR

 A spell of Light Rain / Thundershowers is likely to occur at few places over Delhi and NCR during 14th evening to 15th November.
