### **HOT AND SULTRY WEATHER LIKELY OVER THE PLAINS OF NORTHWEST INDIA**

- Currently mainly dry weather conditions are prevailing over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Rajasthan and West Uttar Pradesh.
- Humidity in the range of 50-70% will be prevailing over plains of Northwest India during next 3-4 days.
- Generally westerly south-westerly winds are prevailing over Rajasthan and westerly winds are prevailing over remaining plains of NW India.
- Under these meteorological conditions, dry weather is likely to prevail over most parts of Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, Rajasthan & West Uttar Pradesh during next 3 days. The meteorological analysis suggests that there is no respite from the prevailing hot & sultry weather till Thursday (14<sup>th</sup> June 2018).
- Thereafter with possibility of duststorm/thunderstorm accompanied with rain, some respite is expected from the evening of Friday (15<sup>th</sup> June 2018) onwards over parts of Northwest India.
