WEATHER FORECAST & WARNING FOR NORTHWEST INDIA INCLUDING DELHI NCR

An active Western Disturbance is likely to affect Northwest India from 23rd February onwards with peak activity on 24th February 2018. In association with this system an induced cyclonic circulation is likely to form over West Rajasthan and neighborhood, as a result of which expected weather & warning are detailed below:-

Weather expected over Northwest India:-

- Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/snowfall activities would occur over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 24th & 25th February 2018.
- Isolated rainfall/ thundershowers activities would occur over Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh on 24th February.

Warning:-

- Isolated Heavy rain /snowfall is very likely to occur over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh & higher reaches of Uttarakhand on 24th February.
- Isolated thunderstorm accompanied with hailstorm is very likely to occur over Jammu division, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Rajasthan & west Uttar Pradesh on 24th February.

Temperature

- There will be rise in maximum temperatures by 2° C to 4° C during 21st to 23rd February over the plains of north-west India..

Weather over Delhi & NCR

Cloudy sky condition with possibility of thundery development is likely to occur over Delhi & NCR on 24th February 2018.
