WEATHER FORECAST & WARNING FOR NORTHWEST INDIA INCLUDING DELHI NCR

An active Western Disturbance is likely to affect in the form of an upper air trough over Northwest India from 22nd January to 24th January with peak activity on 23rd January 2018. In association with this system an induced cyclonic circulation is likely to form over West Rajasthan and neighborhood. Moisture incursion will also take place over the region from Arabian Sea. In association with above systems, the details of expected weather & warning are given below:-

Weather expected over Northwest India:-

- Scattered to Fairly Widespread rainfall/snowfall would occur over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 23rd & isolated on 24th January 2018.
- Fairly wide spread to wide spread rainfall would occur over Haryana, Chandigarh and West Uttar Pradesh on 23rd January and isolated on 24th January.
- Isolated to scattered rainfall would occur over north Rajasthan, Punjab and East Uttar Pradesh on 23rd January and isolated over East Uttar Pradesh on 24th January.

Warning:-

- Isolated Heavy rain /snowfall is very likely to occur over Uttarakhand on 23rd & 24th January.

Weather over Delhi & NCR

- A spell of Light Rain / Thundershower is likely to occur over Delhi & NCR on 23rd **Evening/Night**.
- Moderate to Dense fog is likely to occur over Delhi NCR in the morning of 25th & 26th January.
