WEATHER FORECAST & WARNING FOR NORTHWEST INDIA INCLUDING DELHI NCR

An active Western Disturbance is likely to affect western Himalayan Region and the Plains of North-West India during 10th February to 13th February 2018 with peak activity on 12th February. In association with this system, an induced Cyclonic Circulation is likely to form over South-West Rajasthan & neighborhood. Moisture incursion will also take place over the region from Arabian Sea as well as from Bay of Bengal. The details of expected weather & warning associated with the above system are given below.

Weather expected over Northwest India:-

- Fairly Widespread to Widespread Rain / Snowfall would occur over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Scattered to Fairly widespread Rain / Snowfall would occur over Uttarakhand on 11th & 12th February 2018.
- Isolated to Scattered Rain / Thundershowers would occur over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Rajasthan & west-Uttar Pradesh on 11th and Fairly Wide Spread Rain / Thundershower would also occur over the plains of North-west India on 12th February 2018.

Warning:-

- Isolated Heavy Rain / Snowfall is very likely to occur over J&K, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 11th & 12th February.
- Hailstorm is likely to occur at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and West Uttar Pradesh on 11th February and over Uttar Pradesh on 12th February 2018.

Weather over Delhi & NCR

- A spell of light to moderate rain / thundershowers is likely to occur over Delhi & NCR on 12th February 2018.
