Subject: Heavy Rainfall Activity over North West India

Realised Rainfall During Past 24 Hr ending at 0830hr IST of 24 September 2018

During past 24 hour. many states of North West India have received Fairly Widespread to Widespread rainfall activity accompanied with heavy to very heavy rainfall and isolated extremely heavy falls.

Current Weather Situations:

The low pressure area now lies over North East Rajasthan and adjoining areas of South Haryana and South West Uttar Pradesh. The cyclonic circulation associated with system extends upto 5.8 Km above mean sea level tilting South-Westwards with height. A Western Disturbance also lies as a trough at 7.6 Km above mean sea level roughly along longitude 70⁰ E to the north of latitude 30⁰ N.

Weather Forecast and Warning:

Under the influence of above systems, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, Chandigarh and West Uttar Pradesh are likely to receive widespread rainfall with heavy to very heavy falls during next 24 hour.

Fairly Widespread rainfall with isolated heavy fall is also likely over Punjab and East-Rajasthan during the same period.

Rainfall activity will decrease significantly with effect from 25 September onwards over most States of region.

Forecast for NCR Delhi:

Generally Cloudy Sky with intermittent rain accompanied with one or two intense rain spells in some areas is likely during next 24 hours and decrease thereafter.
